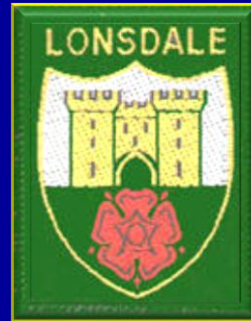

# NIGHTS AWAY PERMIT SCHEME

- Introduced in September 2004
- Introduction of:-
  - Nights Away Advisor(s) (We have got 4 )
  - Nights away permit (Indoor-Camp Site-Green Field)
  - **Notification (Form NAN)**
  - Event passport
- Since 2004 we have issued 90 permits

# NIGHTS AWAY PERMIT SCHEME

- MAIN CHANGES
- 1. **New category** - Light weight expedition
- For staying at any site for not more than **ONE** night before moving on.

# NIGHTS AWAY PERMIT SCHEME

- **2. FIRST AID**
- Although the permit holder has always had the responsibility of ensuring there is first aid provision at the event, there is now a specific requirement for a first aid holder to be present.

# NIGHTS AWAY PERMIT SCHEME

- **3. RENEWAL**
- It is no longer recommended that renewal takes place at the same time as warrant review.
- The permit expires at its expiry date and has to be reapplied for.
- Issued for a maximum of 5 years.

# NIGHTS AWAY PERMIT SCHEME

- CONFIRMATIONS.

- Permits are not section specific.
- Event passports are only for under 18s.
- No maximum age to gain a permit.
- There are no prerequisites to applying for a permit.
- Nights away permit not the same as Module 16.

# NIGHTS AWAY PERMIT SCHEME

- CONFIRMATIONS

- What is a Nights Away Event
- This includes all events where it is intended that young people will sleep overnight.
- When the permit holder needs to be on site
- As a minimum, attend the event during the time that provision is made for young people to be sleeping overnight. They remain responsible for the event at all times.
