Title: ADC (Cub Scouts)

**Outline:** To work in partnership with the District Commissioner to ensure that effective operation of the Cub Scout Section in their District in accordance with the rules as laid down in POR of The Scout Association.

Responsible for: District Cub Scout Leaders and District Young Leaders

Responsible to: Deputy District Commissioner (Programme)

Main Contacts: DC, DDCs, ACC (Cub Scouts), other ADCs, District and County Advisers, District Executive Committee, HQ, ADC (Cub Scouts) from other Districts. Appointment Requirements: To understand and accept The Scout Association's policies, have a satisfactory DBS Clearance, Completion of Wood Badge for Cub Scouts, and completion of the Leadership and Management Training (or be willing to undertake it)

#### Main Tasks:

- Ensure that there is a balanced programme being delivered throughout the District's Cub Sections
- To manage the programme support for new leaders and new sections.
- To lead a District team, to build the profile of the Cub Section, deliver high-quality events, and support the adults within the section.
- To communicate effectively with all adult leaders and young leaders within the section.
- Support linking between Beavers and Cubs, and Cubs and Scouts.
- Increase the number of Cubs achieving Chief Scout Silver Awards
- Increase the number of nights away offered to Cub Scouts.
- Support membership growth across the section.
