Patrol / Team Requirements

- •Minimum of 4 scouts per team, if scout numbers get to 8 2 teams and so on, larger teams or patrols may be possible, but please read on!
- •OL7 and OL41 maps will be required for the event, at least one scout per team should be map and compass literate.
- •One member of the team will need to be 13yrs old and have a Facebook account.
- •One member of the team needs an internet and camara smartphone, with full data and mobile charging available for the duration of the event, hard wired charging will be available at Silverhelme, for the Saturday night, please bring chargers
- •Note: the above can be the same scout, so a 13yr old techie, facebooking, map reading scout with a data connected phone would be ideal!!
- •Each team will require one leader / DBS cleared person with car to transfer team as a unit to their designated drop off location.



How it (basically) will work

- •Given grid co-ordinates, each team will work out a route on the Friday night.
- •Following a very early breakfast, teams will dropped off on the Saturday morning
- •Teams walk the route and will take a Teamie, Selfie or Patrolie!! at given grid references, uploading to a dedicated facebook page.
- •One re-supply will be allowed for the team by the leader, text notification required
- •Points will be awarded as per the "points chart" when a picture hits the facebook page.
- •Bonus points will be awarded for the funniest team pictures
- •A notification will be made to the facebook page every 2 hours as to which team is winning!!
- •1 hour before the event closes the team will notify via text their position, ready for leader collection
- Leaders collect the teams
- Silverhelme for BBQ and well earned rest.
- Leisurely Sunday breakfast, break camp and find out who won!!!

Incorrectly cooked food	Illness	All	High standard of hygiene to be maintained
Slips and Trips	Personal injury	All	No games to played around Tents Torches to be used past dusk Good solid footware to be worn
Extreme weather	Tents blowing away etc	all	Barn and Mortimer Lodge to be available as back up
