This will be someone with good communication and management skills. The District Explorer Scout Commissioner roles will include:

- Co-ordinating a District Explorer Scout Programme
- Chair Leader Meetings
- Working with the District Explorer Scout Administrator and Explorer Finance Sub-Committee to ensure that all units have the resources they need to operate effectively.
- · Promote the section, providing a strategic vision for its development.
- Have oversight of the young leaders scheme working with the leader responsible.
- · Ensure leaders have access to training
- Ensure that young people have a voice in the development of the section
- Ensure that all units are operating safe and exciting programmes and young people are achieving awards.
- Co-ordinate linking between Scouts and Explorers, and Explorers and Network.

The District Explorer Scout Commissioner will lead a team of District Leaders who will support them in the delivery of the above objectives, therefore they will need to be able to delegate effectively. Experience with the Explorer Scout Section is not vital as full training and support will be given, including a handover with the current role holder. The section has developed rapidly over the past five years and we are now looking for someone who can develop the programme and increase the opportunities available to Explorer Scouts.
