Fire Warden's Instructions for Users of Lonsdale Activity Centres Indoor Accommodation



Appointment of a Fire Warden

1. It is the District Trustee Board's requirement that a Fire Warden (a responsible adult) is appointed on each occasion that a Lodge (at either Activity Centre) is used for overnight accommodation.

The Fire Warden's duties are as follows:

- 2. Ensure that the fire alarm system is illuminated and in your opinion in working order.
- 3. Ensure that all fire extinguishers have been identified and are unobstructed.
- 4. Ensure that housekeeping is of the highest standard and that all rubbish is placed in the external waste bins.
- 5. Ensure that all exit routes are clear and unobstructed and that exit doors can be opened easily.
- 6 Ensure that at night (or when the building is vacated) the relevant gas/electrical appliances in the kitchen have been turned-off.
- 7. Ensure that all occupants are fully briefed in relation to the evacuation of the building in the event of a fire (and consider undertaking a fire drill towards the start of your occupancy of the building do so by shouting rather than activating the fire alarm system).
- 8. Ensure that plans have been made, in advance, to assist those who may have difficulties (such as mobility) should an evacuation of the building be necessary.
- 9. Ensure that everyone understands that no one should attempt to fight a fire unless they have been trained to do so (and that in doing so will not put themselves or others in additional danger).
- 10. Ensure that there is no smoking, including vaping, anywhere within the boundary of the Activity Centre.

11. Action in the event of a fire:

- a. Ensure that the alarm is raised (by voice if a fire is not automatically detected).
- b. Supervise the evacuation of the building.
- c. Only attempt to fight a fire if trained to do so and that such action will not put anyone in additional danger.
- d. Ensure that the Emergency Services are alerted; the preferred method is to logon to the site's WiFi (as mobile signals are generally very poor through much of the sites).
- e. Ensure that all occupants assemble in the Car Park and have been accounted for.
- f. Ensure that the Duty Warden is notified.
