1. Review Minutes of 5 September 2011 Meeting

There was nothing additional to report that was not on the agenda for this meeting.

3. Competitions Update:

a. Hiking Competition 2011, 1 - 2 October

It was felt that some teams in the seniors hike could have taken more advantage of footpaths rather than using roads. This would have been safer and more interesting. This should not be done as John needed to know where to look for teams in the event of their being over time at a checkpoint, based on their Route Plan.

Mark indicated that training in navigation could be mounted for leaders, if this was required.
